FCSS Homelessness Study – David Beale

FCSS reached out to a group of community agencies and organizations in Bonnyville to assess their perception of the current state of Homelessness in our community. There were some differing views but for the most part there is a consensus that overall there has been a decrease in homelessness with the downturn in the economy.

At this time there are no specific actions being recommended and FCSS will continue to support those in need and work with
